- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under California cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ California home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

DELIVERY / PICKUP RULES	CFO: direct/indirect sales within California only. MEHKO: on-site dining, pickup, delivery by operator/staff. MEHKO food must be prepared and delivered same day. State preemption bars local restriction of CFOs.
MAX EMPLOYEES IN HOME	1 full-time equivalent for CFO (state baseline); MEHKO: 1 non-family employee (county ordinance per MEHKO SOP — max 40 hr/week)

Alameda County Ordinance 6.68 (MEHKO); Cal. Health & Safety Code §113758 (CFO)

RESEARCH NOTES

Alameda County is a MEHKO opt-in county. MEHKO permit fee: \$696 (initial). ACDEH holds free monthly information sessions (first Wednesday, 9-10am). City of Berkeley operates its own separate EH program and is excluded from ACDEH jurisdiction. CFO applicants must obtain city planning approval before ACDEH registration. MEHKO governed by Alameda County Ordinance 6.68.

State context — California cottage food law

Alameda County's rules sit on top of California's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.
