- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under California cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ California home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

RESEARCH NOTES

Alpine County is the least populous county in California (~1,200 residents). Environmental health services are contracted to El Dorado County EHS. No county-specific cottage food rules found beyond state baseline. CFO registration/permit obtained through El Dorado County EHS on behalf of Alpine County. State law preempts local zoning restrictions. Class A annual gross sales cap ~\$86,206 (2025, CPI-adjusted); Class B ~\$172,411. Food safety training required (ANSI-accredited, valid 3 years).

State context — California cottage food law

Alpine County's rules sit on top of California's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.
