- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under Colorado cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Colorado home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

Possibly — Colorado cottage food law (C.R.S. §25-4-1614) does not require a local permit, but Alamosa County zoning rules for home-based businesses may apply. Producers should verify with Alamosa County Planning/Zoning whether a home occupation permit is needed. San Luis Valley Development Resources Group (SLVDRG) may have local business resources. No county-specific cottage food ordinance found.

LOCAL BUSINESS LICENSE

Possibly; City of Alamosa may require a city business license for operations within city limits; confirm with City of Alamosa

C.R.S. §25-4-1614 (Colorado Cottage Foods Act); Alamosa County Land Use Code

RESEARCH NOTES

No Alamosa County-specific cottage food ordinance found beyond state baseline. San Luis Valley county; county seat Alamosa is home to Adams State University. Colorado cottage food law does not preempt local zoning; producers should check home occupation zoning status. CDPHE registration not required but food safety course must be completed before starting. \$10,000 annual cap per product type (not total revenue). HB 26-1033 (Tamale Act) pending as of 2026 may expand law if enacted.

State context — Colorado cottage food law

Alamosa County's rules sit on top of Colorado's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

STATUTE

C.R.S. §25-4-1614

No — Products cannot be resold; producers must sell directly to consumers but may designate a representative to sell on their behalf. Sales through restaurants or retail stores are not permitted, though the health department may allow direct sales at those locations on a case-by-case basis.
