- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under Colorado cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Colorado home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

Relevant county code

Telluride Land Use Code §6-104, §6-106 (Home Occupations As Uses Permitted On Review)

RESEARCH NOTES

Town of Telluride LUC §6-106 requires Planning & Zoning review/approval for home occupations. On-site sales of goods produced on-site (cottage food) are explicitly allowed under §6-106.C. Business license required from Town of Telluride. Unincorporated San Miguel County rules not separately retrieved; recommend verifying with county planning. High-value resort county — zoning strictly enforced.

State context — Colorado cottage food law

San Miguel County's rules sit on top of Colorado's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

C.R.S. §25-4-1614

INDIRECT SALES

No — Products cannot be resold; producers must sell directly to consumers but may designate a representative to sell on their behalf. Sales through restaurants or retail stores are not permitted, though the health department may allow direct sales at those locations on a case-by-case basis.
