- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Florida home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

RESEARCH NOTES

Florida's strong state preemption (Fla. Stat. §500.80(6)) means Lafayette County cannot restrict cottage food operations beyond traffic, parking, noise, signage, and hours rules. Lafayette County is one of Florida's smallest and most rural counties; no county-specific ordinance variations were found. Defaulted to FL state baseline with medium confidence.

State context — Florida cottage food law

Lafayette County's rules sit on top of Florida's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Limited (see notes) — Florida prohibits wholesale sales but allows online, mail-order, and in-person sales including delivery to consumers; state law preempts local restrictions on cottage food operations.
