- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity

RESEARCH NOTES

Gwinnett County's business license page confirms home-based businesses require an Occupational Tax Certificate, Home-Based Business Disclosure, and driver's license matching the business address. The GDA cottage food page confirms HB 398 (July 1, 2025) removed the state licensing requirement for cottage food but food safety training remains required. No specific Gwinnett County ordinance restricting cottage food beyond state baseline was found, but the business license/occupational tax requirement applies. For businesses inside incorporated cities in Gwinnett (e.g., Duluth, Suwanee, Lawrenceville), separate municipal rules apply.

State context — Georgia cottage food law

Gwinnett County's rules sit on top of Georgia's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — As of July 1, 2025 (HB 398), Georgia allows wholesale, online, retail store, restaurant, and mail-order sales; third-party sellers must display cottage food products separately and label the section as products from residential kitchens exempt from state inspection.
