- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under Louisiana cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Louisiana home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

INSPECTION REQUIRED	No — No routine inspection required under state cottage food law
HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT	Conditional — Caddo Parish and City of Shreveport may require home occupation permit or business license. No county URLs provided in input. Check with Caddo Parish Planning Department or City of Shreveport Permits.

RESEARCH NOTES

Caddo Parish LA follows Louisiana state cottage food law. \$30,000 cap. No county URLs provided and no parish-specific ordinance found. Caddo Parish includes Shreveport, a major regional hub. Confidence medium — state law confirmed but no specific Caddo Parish .gov cottage food source retrieved.

State context — Louisiana cottage food law

Caddo Parish's rules sit on top of Louisiana's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Limited (see notes) — Most low-risk foods may be sold indirectly (to restaurants, retail stores), but breads, cakes, cookies, and pies specifically may NOT be sold to any retail business or individual for resale — they are direct-to-consumer only.
