- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under Louisiana cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Louisiana home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

Yes (Low-risk foods only: baked goods, candies, jams/jellies/preserves, pickles/acidified foods, sauces/syrups, spices, honey. No animal or fish muscle protein. Annual cap \$30,000. No employees permitted for baked goods (breads/cakes/cookies/pies). Pets excluded from preparation areas. A sales tax certificate from the parish of sale required.)

No (No inspection required at state level. Parish health may act on complaint.)

Home kitchen rules

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED	Yes — Low-risk foods only: baked goods, candies, jams/jellies/preserves, pickles/acidified foods, sauces/syrups, spices, honey. No animal or fish muscle protein. Annual cap \$30,000. No employees permitted for baked goods (breads/cakes/cookies/pies). Pets excluded from preparation areas. A sales tax certificate from the parish of sale required.
SEPARATE DEDICATED KITCHEN	No
PET RESTRICTIONS	Pets must be excluded from food preparation areas during production of breads, cakes, cookies, and pies (state law).
WATER SUPPLY	No specific state requirement beyond standard sanitation.
HANDWASHING	Standard sanitation practices; no formal certification required.
FOOD STORAGE	Refrigeration required at 45°F or below for perishable ingredients in baked goods. Shelf-stable products stored appropriately.

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED	No — No inspection required at state level. Parish health may act on complaint.
HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT	Conditional — A sales tax certificate from Vermilion Parish of sale is required before selling. No specific Vermilion Parish cottage food zoning ordinance identified. Parish-level business license requirements may vary; contact Vermilion Parish Government in Abbeville.

ON-SITE CUSTOMER PICKUP	Conditional
ON-SITE SIGNAGE	Conditional
DELIVERY / PICKUP RULES	Most low-risk foods (except the four named baked goods categories) can be sold through indirect channels. Direct and some indirect sales allowed. No online/mail-order restriction noted in statute.
MAX EMPLOYEES IN HOME	No employees may assist in production of breads, cakes, cookies, or pies under LA law.

La. R.S. §40:4.9; parish sales tax certificate requirement

RESEARCH NOTES

No Vermilion Parish-specific cottage food rules found. State baseline applies: \$30,000 cap (raised from \$20,000 by Act 357, 2022). Louisiana is notable for allowing indirect sales of most low-risk foods except the four named baked goods categories. Parish sales tax certificate required. Cottage food is regulated at the state level only; no parish health inspection.

State context — Louisiana cottage food law

Vermilion Parish's rules sit on top of Louisiana's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Limited (see notes) — Most low-risk foods may be sold indirectly (to restaurants, retail stores), but breads, cakes, cookies, and pies specifically may NOT be sold to any retail business or individual for resale — they are direct-to-consumer only.
