- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under Maine cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Maine home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

INSPECTION REQUIRED	Yes — Kitchen inspection required by ME DACF for statewide Home Food Processor License. Local food sovereignty ordinances may not require inspection.

State context — Maine cottage food law

Lincoln County's rules sit on top of Maine's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — Under the statewide Home Food Processor License, producers may sell at any venue including restaurants, retail stores, farmers markets, and online, with no sales limit; indirect wholesale and retail channels are allowed once licensed and kitchen-inspected.
