- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ Michigan home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED

Yes — Michigan allows non-potentially hazardous foods from home kitchens. Annual sales cap of \$50,000 (raised from \$25,000 by 2025 HB 4122, effective March 2026). No registration, no inspection, no training required. Direct-to-consumer sales only — no wholesale or consignment. Online/mail order/third-party delivery permitted (2025 amendment).

No specific state pet restriction, but standard sanitation practices apply.

WATER SUPPLY

No specific state requirement beyond standard sanitation.

HANDWASHING

Standard handwashing practices required.

FOOD STORAGE

Non-potentially hazardous foods only. Acidified foods, low-acid canned foods, fruit butters, pickles, fermented foods, salsas, sauces, ketchup, mustards, meat jerkies, juices, carbonated drinks, kombucha prohibited. Only two specified buttercream frosting recipes permitted.

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED

No — No routine inspections. Michigan cottage food operations are exempt from MDARD licensing.

HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT

Conditional — Eaton County municipalities (Charlotte, Grand Ledge, Eaton Rapids, etc.) may have home occupation or home business zoning requirements. No specific Eaton County-level cottage food ordinance identified. Operators should check with their local municipality.

No specific Eaton County code section identified. State law governs: MCL §289.4102.

RESEARCH NOTES

Eaton County has no county URLs in the input. State baseline governs. Michigan's 2025 amendment (HB 4122) doubled the cap to \$50,000 and added online/mail order sales. Effective date is March 2026. Eaton County is adjacent to Lansing (Ingham County) in the capital region. No county-specific overrides found. Confidence medium.

State context — Michigan cottage food law

Eaton County's rules sit on top of Michigan's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

INDIRECT SALES

No — Sales through retail stores, restaurants, or wholesale are prohibited. Online sales, mail order, and third-party delivery platform sales (e.g., DoorDash) are allowed in-state only, but require the producer to offer the customer an opportunity to directly interact (face-to-face or virtually) before purchase. A separate \$75,000 cap applies if all products are priced at \$250 or more per item. Honey and maple syrup have a separate exemption permitting indirect retail sales up to \$15,000/year.
