- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under New Jersey cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ New Jersey home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

QUICK VIEW FOR BAKERS IN THIS COUNTY

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED?

Yes (New Jersey requires a Cottage Food Operator Permit from the NJ Department of Health. Only non-TCS foods are permitted. Annual gross sales cap of \$50,000. Operator must hold Food Protection Manager Certification. Private well water requires potability test. Local zoning board approval confirming residential use is permitted is required before a permit is issued.)

Pets must be excluded from food preparation areas during production per standard NJ food safety requirements.

HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT?

Yes (NJ requires local zoning board approval confirming that operating a cottage food business from the residence is permitted under local zoning before the state permit is issued. Warren County municipalities each have their own zoning ordinances. Warren County does not have a county-level home occupation permit; operators must check with their specific municipality.)

Home kitchen rules

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED

Yes — New Jersey requires a Cottage Food Operator Permit from the NJ Department of Health. Only non-TCS foods are permitted. Annual gross sales cap of \$50,000. Operator must hold Food Protection Manager Certification. Private well water requires potability test. Local zoning board approval confirming residential use is permitted is required before a permit is issued.

SEPARATE DEDICATED KITCHEN

PET RESTRICTIONS

Pets must be excluded from food preparation areas during production per standard NJ food safety requirements.

WATER SUPPLY

Private well water requires a potability test submitted with the permit application. Public water supply utility bill acceptable.

HANDWASHING

Standard handwashing facilities required per NJ food safety rules.

FOOD STORAGE

All ingredients and finished products must be stored properly to prevent contamination; non-TCS foods only.

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED	Upon-complaint — Health authority may enter and inspect upon complaint or suspected foodborne illness. No routine pre-operational kitchen inspection required, but the permit application process includes review of zoning approval and water potability.

MAX EMPLOYEES IN HOME	Not specified in state statute; cottage food is a personal residential operation.

Relevant county code

No specific Warren County code section identified for cottage food. State law governs: N.J.A.C. 8:24-11.

RESEARCH NOTES

Warren County has no county URLs in the input and no specific cottage food overrides were found. State baseline governs. NJ is among the last states to legalize cottage food (2021). Key requirements: NJ CFO Permit (\$100, 2-year), Food Protection Manager Certification (not just food handler), local zoning board approval, \$50,000 annual sales cap, non-TCS foods only. Application review takes 12-16 weeks. No county-specific rules found. Confidence medium because local zoning verification requires checking each municipality within Warren County.

State context — New Jersey cottage food law

Warren County's rules sit on top of New Jersey's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

INDIRECT SALES

No — Cottage food products may only be delivered or relinquished at: the operator's home (not for onsite consumption), the consumer's NJ home, a NJ farmers market or other permitted NJ location. Products cannot be sold to wholesale establishments, retail food establishments, or shipped out of state. Online and phone order-taking is allowed as an ancillary activity, but physical delivery must occur in New Jersey person-to-person or at permitted locations. Charitable bake sales remain exempt under separate provisions.
