- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under New York cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ New York home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

No online sales out-of-state. Products must be pre-packaged and labeled.

PET RESTRICTIONS	No specific NY state restriction on pets; good manufacturing practices apply.
WATER SUPPLY	No specific water testing requirement under NY Home Processor Exemption.
HANDWASHING	Good manufacturing practices apply; adequate handwashing expected.
FOOD STORAGE	Shelf-stable pre-packaged products only; no refrigerated or TCS products.

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED	No — No routine inspection. Complaint-based enforcement by NYSDAM.
HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT	Varies — Schenectady County and the City of Schenectady may require home occupation permits under local zoning. No county-specific cottage food overlay identified.

State context — New York cottage food law

Schenectady County's rules sit on top of New York's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — Wholesale to restaurants, cafes, and grocery stores within New York State is explicitly permitted. Products may also be sold online (NY residents only) and via delivery. Shipping out of state is not permitted. Registration is free, location-specific, and has no expiration date.
