- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under New York cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ New York home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

RESEARCH NOTES

NY Home Processor Exemption administered by NY Ag & Markets (Rochester office serves Seneca County). Seneca County is a Finger Lakes county with wine and tourism industry; no county-specific cottage food restrictions beyond the state framework found. Local zoning in individual towns/villages is not preempted by the state program. Home Processor registration is free and does not expire but is location-specific. Medium confidence because local zoning varies at the town level in NY.

State context — New York cottage food law

Seneca County's rules sit on top of New York's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — Wholesale to restaurants, cafes, and grocery stores within New York State is explicitly permitted. Products may also be sold online (NY residents only) and via delivery. Shipping out of state is not permitted. Registration is free, location-specific, and has no expiration date.
