Where to file

State

Alabama registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Indirect sales to grocery stores, restaurants, or wholesale are not permitted; producers may use an agent for delivery but cannot sell through retailers.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Athens and Limestone County municipalities may have home occupation zoning requirements. No specific Limestone County cottage food ordinance identified beyond the state county health department approval requirement.

Health

Yes. Limestone County Health Department must approve applications. Requires proof of training, sample label, product list. Fees and approval vary by county.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer sales only. No wholesale or indirect sales. Online and in-state shipping permitted. Out-of-state shipping prohibited.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commercial kitchen is a food establishment. Alabama cottage food is not a food-service permit. A commissary, restaurant, or shared kitchen is a food establishment permitted by the county health department. Ask that office for the food-facility application, not the cottage-food form.
