Where to file

State

Alabama registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Indirect sales to grocery stores, restaurants, or wholesale are not permitted; producers may use an agent for delivery but cannot sell through retailers.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Alabama county health departments approve cottage food applications and may impose local requirements. Morgan County Environmental Health (part of Alabama Department of Public Health district) administers approval process. Producers must submit proof of food safety training, sample label, and product list. Fees vary by county. No specific home occupation permit information found for Morgan County beyond state health department approval process.

Health

No. Alabama does not require routine kitchen inspections. County health departments review applications. Complaint-driven investigation possible.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Alabama allows direct sales and online/in-state shipping (as of 2021 amendment). Interstate shipping not permitted. No wholesale or retail store channels.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commercial kitchen is a food establishment. Alabama cottage food is not a food-service permit. A commissary, restaurant, or shared kitchen is a food establishment permitted by the county health department. Ask that office for the food-facility application, not the cottage-food form.
