Where to file

State

Alabama registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Indirect sales to grocery stores, restaurants, or wholesale are not permitted; producers may use an agent for delivery but cannot sell through retailers.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Walker County Health Department administers cottage food approvals. Application with proof of food safety training, sample label, and product list required. Contact Walker County Health Department at (205) 387-2547.

Direct sales only; online sales and in-state shipping allowed since 2021. No interstate shipping.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commercial kitchen is a food establishment. Alabama cottage food is not a food-service permit. A commissary, restaurant, or shared kitchen is a food establishment permitted by the county health department. Ask that office for the food-facility application, not the cottage-food form.
