This is what it takes to sell from a home kitchen in Graham County. Confirm each step with Planning, Health, and the license office before you sell.

What you need

Graham County, Arizona. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Arizona registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Retail and wholesale sales are allowed for non-dairy/non-meat products; stores must display homemade products separately from commercially produced items; dairy and meat products must be sold directly in person (online orders allowed but must be delivered in person, not via third-party platforms).

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional — check county zoning. No county-specific home occupation ordinance confirmed restricting cottage food. State law (A.R.S. §36-932) authorizes home kitchen sales. Producers should verify with county planning/zoning if their jurisdiction has home occupation rules applicable to food sales from home.

Business license

Conditional — check with county

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales, online sales, and retail/wholesale indirect sales all permitted; no sales cap under Arizona law

If you rent a commissary kitchen

County health permits food establishments. Arizona cottage food is a separate home path. A rented kitchen is a food establishment under the county health department that issues retail food permits.
