Where to file

State

Arizona registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Retail and wholesale sales are allowed for non-dairy/non-meat products; stores must display homemade products separately from commercially produced items; dairy and meat products must be sold directly in person (online orders allowed but must be delivered in person, not via third-party platforms).

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Yuma County (unincorporated areas) and City of Yuma may require home occupation permits. Contact Yuma County Planning & Zoning (yumacountyaz.gov) or City of Yuma Planning for home occupation requirements. Arizona does not preempt local home occupation zoning requirements.

Health

No. No routine inspections under Arizona cottage food law. AZ DHS may investigate upon complaint.

Business license

Pickup / delivery

Arizona cottage food allows broad sales channels: direct from home, online, at events, through retailers. The 2024 expansion added perishable food sales options.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

County health permits food establishments. Arizona cottage food is a separate home path. A rented kitchen is a food establishment under the county health department that issues retail food permits.
