What you need

St. Francis County, Arkansas. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Arkansas registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Retail and wholesale sales are allowed so long as the product is sold to an informed end consumer who can see the product label; sales to businesses for ingredient use or gift resale are not permitted.

Zoning / home occupation

No — state law preempts local restrictions. A.C.A. §20-57-201 explicitly preempts both state and local government from restricting home food producers; no county-level home occupation permit required for cottage food

Health

No. No routine inspection required under Act 1040; complaint-based investigation possible

Business license

No — preempted by state law

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales permitted; indirect sales through retail/wholesale allowed; interstate sales permitted

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary needs a food-service permit. Arkansas cottage food does not replace a food-service permit. Shared and commercial kitchens are permitted by the Arkansas Department of Health.
