Riverside County, California. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

If you want a shop or a rented commercial kitchen, these rows do not apply.

HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

California cottage food is registered at the county. CDPH does not issue cottage-food permits. Class A registration and Class B permits are handled by the county (or city) environmental health department where you live. If this file only has a county homepage, call Environmental Health and ask for the cottage-food (CFO) page. Class A is registration. Class B is a permit.

Where to file

State

California registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Class B permit holders may sell indirectly through retail stores and restaurants statewide; Class A registrants are limited to direct sales only and may not sell through any retail or wholesale venue.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies by city. California Gov. Code §51035 preempts local zoning restrictions on CFOs. Cities within Riverside County may require home occupation permits for other business aspects. No county-specific home occupation permit requirement identified for CFOs in unincorporated areas.

Health

Conditional. Class A: no routine inspection; complaint-based. Class B: annual inspection required for permit issuance/renewal.

Pickup / delivery

Direct/indirect sales within California only. State baseline applies. Operator may hire up to 1 full-time employee.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

CDPH does not permit commissaries. Counties do. California cottage food (Class A/B) is county environmental health. A commissary, restaurant, or shared kitchen is a retail food facility under CalCode, also at county environmental health, on a different application than the CFO form.
