HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

California cottage food is registered at the county. CDPH does not issue cottage-food permits. Class A registration and Class B permits are handled by the county (or city) environmental health department where you live. If this file only has a county homepage, call Environmental Health and ask for the cottage-food (CFO) page. Class A is registration. Class B is a permit.

Where to file

State

California registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Class B permit holders may sell indirectly through retail stores and restaurants statewide; Class A registrants are limited to direct sales only and may not sell through any retail or wholesale venue.

Zoning / home occupation

True. California state law (GOV §51035) preempts local zoning restrictions on cottage food operations. Sierra County Environmental Health processes CFO registrations (Class A) and permits (Class B). Extremely rural and sparsely populated northern Sierra Nevada county (population under 3,000). Contact Sierra County Environmental Health for registration.

County has no incorporated cities; unincorporated county areas generally do not require a county business license; confirm with Sierra County

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales and delivery within California only; no interstate sales per state law

If you rent a commissary kitchen

CDPH does not permit commissaries. Counties do. California cottage food (Class A/B) is county environmental health. A commissary, restaurant, or shared kitchen is a retail food facility under CalCode, also at county environmental health, on a different application than the CFO form.
