What you need

Baker County, Florida. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Florida registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Florida prohibits wholesale sales but allows online, mail-order, and in-person sales including delivery to consumers; state law preempts local restrictions on cottage food operations.

Zoning / home occupation

Yes (Baker County local occupational license required for home-based businesses). Baker County Tax Collector issues Occupational Licenses per Ordinance 99-17. Home occupation rules administered by Baker County Building & Zoning (904-259-2403). Definition: business from home where no commodity is produced on premises, can be sold on premises, nor displayed/warehoused. Cottage food sales (non-TCS goods produced at home) may require Board of Adjustments approval for home occupation. Contact Baker County Building & Zoning to confirm whether cottage food production qualifies and if Board approval is needed.

Health

Upon-complaint only. State inspection only upon receipt of complaint per Fla. Stat. §500.80(7); county cannot add inspections

Business license

Yes; Baker County Occupational License from Tax Collector; contact (904) 259-6880

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer; online/mail-order allowed; shipping within and across state lines via USPS or commercial carrier; no wholesale/consignment; max \$250,000 annual gross sales

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DBPR or the local health department licenses food. Florida public food service is typically DBPR Hotels and Restaurants or the county health department, depending on the operation. Cottage food is a separate exemption. Ask which office licenses the kitchen you rent.
