What you need

Glades County, Florida. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Florida registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Florida prohibits wholesale sales but allows online, mail-order, and in-person sales including delivery to consumers; state law preempts local restrictions on cottage food operations.

Zoning / home occupation

Likely; verify with Glades County. No Glades County-specific home occupation ordinance text located in search. Very small, rural agricultural county (pop. ~13,000) with county seat Moore Haven. One of Florida's least populous counties. Local business tax receipt and possible zoning approval likely required. State preempts county from banning cottage food.

Health

Upon-complaint only. State inspection only upon receipt of complaint per Fla. Stat. §500.80(7); county cannot add inspections

Business license

Likely; Glades County local business tax receipt; contact Glades County Tax Collector

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer; online/mail-order allowed; shipping within and across state lines via USPS or commercial carrier; no wholesale/consignment; max \$250,000 annual gross sales

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DBPR or the local health department licenses food. Florida public food service is typically DBPR Hotels and Restaurants or the county health department, depending on the operation. Cottage food is a separate exemption. Ask which office licenses the kitchen you rent.
