Santa Rosa County, Florida. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Florida registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Florida prohibits wholesale sales but allows online, mail-order, and in-person sales including delivery to consumers; state law preempts local restrictions on cottage food operations.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. State preemption (§500.80(6)) prohibits local restrictions on cottage food operations. However, producers must comply with home-based business rules under §559.955. Santa Rosa County has no specific county-level cottage food overlay beyond state law. Local municipalities within the county (e.g., Milton) may have home occupation permit requirements.

Health

Upon-complaint. Inspections only permitted upon receipt of a consumer complaint per §500.80(7). No routine inspections allowed.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Online sales and mail-order delivery expressly permitted. Sales at farmers markets, home, and other direct venues allowed.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DBPR or the local health department licenses food. Florida public food service is typically DBPR Hotels and Restaurants or the county health department, depending on the operation. Cottage food is a separate exemption. Ask which office licenses the kitchen you rent.
