HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

Georgia no longer sells a state cottage-food license. HB 398 (effective July 1, 2025) removed the Georgia Department of Agriculture cottage-food license and fee. What may still apply is city or county occupational tax and zoning. This packet keeps the GDA program page so you can read the current state rules.

Where to file

State

Georgia registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. As of July 1, 2025 (HB 398), Georgia allows wholesale, online, retail store, restaurant, and mail-order sales; third-party sellers must display cottage food products separately and label the section as products from residential kitchens exempt from state inspection.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Floyd County and City of Rome may have local home occupation zoning requirements. No Floyd County-specific cottage food permit identified. Georgia state law does not expressly preempt local zoning for cottage food; operators should verify with Floyd County Planning.

Health

Upon-complaint. Georgia Department of Agriculture may inspect upon consumer complaint under §26-2-470 et seq.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Under post-July 2025 law, sales allowed at farmers markets, online, from home, to retail stores, restaurants, wholesale. Interstate sales now expressly allowed.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service permit, not occupational tax. Georgia no longer sells a GDA cottage license (HB 398). A rented kitchen is still a food-service establishment permitted by the county health department or the Department of Public Health. Occupational tax is not that permit.
