HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

Georgia no longer sells a state cottage-food license. HB 398 (effective July 1, 2025) removed the Georgia Department of Agriculture cottage-food license and fee. What may still apply is city or county occupational tax and zoning. This packet keeps the GDA program page so you can read the current state rules.

Where to file

State

Georgia registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. As of July 1, 2025 (HB 398), Georgia allows wholesale, online, retail store, restaurant, and mail-order sales; third-party sellers must display cottage food products separately and label the section as products from residential kitchens exempt from state inspection.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Hall County and municipalities (Gainesville, Oakwood, Flowery Branch) may have home occupation zoning requirements. Contact Hall County Planning & Zoning or relevant municipal planning office. Georgia HB 398 removed state licensing requirements but local zoning still applies.

Health

Upon-complaint. Complaint-based only under Georgia HB 398 (eff. July 2025). No routine or pre-operational inspections.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Georgia HB 398 allows all sales channels including direct from home, online, through retailers, restaurants, wholesalers, and interstate sales.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service permit, not occupational tax. Georgia no longer sells a GDA cottage license (HB 398). A rented kitchen is still a food-service establishment permitted by the county health department or the Department of Public Health. Occupational tax is not that permit.
