Where to file

State

Idaho registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Idaho prohibits wholesale, restaurant, and retail store sales; only direct-to-consumer in-person sales at home, farmers markets, events, online (pickup/delivery), and roadside stands are allowed.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Adams County is a very small, rural county (pop. ~4,300). Idaho counties typically require a home occupation permit or conditional use permit for home-based businesses in residential zones. Business must be secondary to residential use, operated by a resident, with no exterior signage or commercial evidence, and limited customer traffic. Contact Adams County Clerk/Planning at (208) 253-4561 for specific county zoning requirements.

Health

No. No routine inspection. Southwest District Health (serving Adams County) may investigate upon complaint or suspected foodborne illness.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Idaho cottage food allows direct sales to consumers; pickup at home is permitted. Customer visits that generate significant traffic may require a home occupation permit from county planning. Delivery to consumers is permitted. No mail order or internet sales allowed under state law.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Health districts permit food establishments. Idaho cottage food is a home exemption. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the local public health district.
