Where to file

State

Idaho registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Idaho prohibits wholesale, restaurant, and retail store sales; only direct-to-consumer in-person sales at home, farmers markets, events, online (pickup/delivery), and roadside stands are allowed.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. The City of Twin Falls (county seat) requires a Zoning Use Permit (\$250 fee) for home occupations that generate customer traffic. Home occupation must comply with Title 10-6 of the Twin Falls City Code. If a cottage food business generates customer pickup traffic, a use permit is required. Unincorporated Twin Falls County areas have separate county zoning rules; contact Twin Falls County Planning at (208) 735-7267.

Health

No. No routine inspection. IDHW may investigate upon complaint or suspected foodborne illness.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Idaho cottage food allows direct sales to consumers; pickup at home is permitted. Customer visits that generate significant traffic may require a home occupation use permit from the City of Twin Falls Planning & Zoning. Delivery to consumers is permitted. No mail order or internet sales allowed under state law (direct sales only).

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Health districts permit food establishments. Idaho cottage food is a home exemption. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the local public health district.
