Where to file

State

Illinois registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Illinois prohibits sales to restaurants, retail stores, and wholesale; direct in-state sales are allowed anywhere including home, online, farmers markets, events, and roadside stands; non-perishable items may be shipped within Illinois only.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Registration required with Boone County Health Department (up to \$50/year). Boone County is in the northern Illinois area near Rockford. Contact Boone County Health Department in Belvidere.

Health

Upon-complaint. Boone County Health Department may inspect upon complaint.

Business license

Conditional

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales only within Illinois. Online sales allowed; non-perishable items shipped within IL only.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health departments license food facilities. Illinois cottage food registers with the local health department. A commissary or restaurant is a retail food establishment, also at that department, on a different permit.
