Where to file

State

Indiana registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Sales to restaurants, retail stores, and wholesale are prohibited; producers may sell at events, farmers markets, home, online, and roadside stands only.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Indiana preempts local licensing and inspection requirements for home-based vendors. Clark County and Jeffersonville city may have general home occupation zoning permits. No specific Clark County cottage food overlay found. Indiana state law is clear that local governments cannot impose additional requirements beyond zoning.

Health

Upon-complaint. Indiana state law prohibits local health departments from adding licensing or inspection requirements. Inspection only upon complaint or illness investigation.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Indiana allows direct sales only: from home, online, farmers markets, events. No wholesale to restaurants or retail stores. Interstate sales and acidified foods in oxygen-sealed containers prohibited.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health departments license retail food. Indiana home-based vendor rules do not replace a retail food establishment permit. A commissary is licensed by the local health department.
