Where to file

State

Kansas registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Indirect sales to restaurants, retail stores, or wholesale are not allowed under the exemption; producers needing wholesale or retail channels must obtain a KDA food processing license.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Saline County includes Salina, a mid-sized city. City of Salina may require a local home occupation permit or business license. No specific Saline County cottage food ordinance identified. Contact Saline County/City of Salina government.

Health

Upon-complaint. Kansas Dept. of Agriculture may investigate on complaint. No routine inspections.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct to consumer anywhere. Out-of-state sales allowed with additional requirements (per KSU Extension MF3138 guide). No indirect/wholesale sales.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

KDA licenses food establishments. Kansas cottage food is an exemption from a food-establishment license. Selling from a commissary typically requires a KDA food establishment or food processing license.
