Where to file

State

Kansas registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Indirect sales to restaurants, retail stores, or wholesale are not allowed under the exemption; producers needing wholesale or retail channels must obtain a KDA food processing license.

Zoning / home occupation

Yes. Kansas City, KS (Wyandotte County is a unified city-county government) requires a Home Occupied Zoning Memorandum submission and a Home Occupation Tax Application (occupation tax license) for home-based businesses. Steps: (1) Submit Home Occupied Zoning Memorandum; (2) Submit Home Occupation Tax Application after zoning approval. Business from residence: contact Neighborhood Resource Center at 913-573-8780. Kansas Cottage Food Law allows home food sales without a food license.

Health

Upon-complaint. No routine inspections. Kansas Dept. of Agriculture may investigate upon complaint.

Business license

Yes

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales from home, farmers markets, online with delivery. Out-of-state sales with additional requirements.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

KDA licenses food establishments. Kansas cottage food is an exemption from a food-establishment license. Selling from a commissary typically requires a KDA food establishment or food processing license.
