Pulaski County, Kentucky. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Kentucky registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Sales limited to direct-to-consumer only within Kentucky — from home (pickup or delivery), markets, roadside stands, community events, and online; shipping outside Kentucky is prohibited, and sales to restaurants or retail stores for resale are not allowed.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Pulaski County (Somerset area) is in south-central Kentucky. No specific county home occupation permit for cottage food identified. Contact Pulaski County Planning or Somerset city for local zoning.

Health

Upon-complaint. Complaint-based inspection; routine inspection not required

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales only; no wholesale or retail sales. Internet sales within Kentucky allowed.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health departments permit food service. Kentucky cottage food / home-based processor paths do not replace a food-service permit. A commissary is permitted by the local health department.
