Where to file

State

Louisiana registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Most low-risk foods may be sold indirectly (to restaurants, retail stores), but breads, cakes, cookies, and pies specifically may NOT be sold to any retail business or individual for resale — they are direct-to-consumer only.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Bossier Parish zoning ordinance may require home occupation permit. Bossier City (the largest city, adjacent to Shreveport) has its own ordinances. Parish sales tax certificate required. No specific parish-level cottage food ordinance identified.

Health

No. LDH may investigate upon complaint.

Business license

Pickup / delivery

Indirect sales allowed for most low-risk foods. Direct sales from home, farmers markets, and events permitted.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

LDH permits retail food. Louisiana cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a retail food establishment permitted by the Louisiana Department of Health.
