Where to file

State

Louisiana registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Most low-risk foods may be sold indirectly (to restaurants, retail stores), but breads, cakes, cookies, and pies specifically may NOT be sold to any retail business or individual for resale — they are direct-to-consumer only.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. No parish-specific home occupation ordinance identified. Local ordinances are NOT preempted by state law. Parish may have home occupation zoning requirements. Sales tax certificate from parish tax authority required before selling.

Health

No. No routine inspection; complaint-based enforcement possible

Business license

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer (home, farmers markets, roadside stands, fairs, events, online within LA, mail within LA). Big Four direct-to-consumer only. Most other products may be sold wholesale to retail stores/restaurants within LA. No interstate shipping.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

LDH permits retail food. Louisiana cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a retail food establishment permitted by the Louisiana Department of Health.
