Muskegon County, Michigan. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Michigan registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales through retail stores, restaurants, or wholesale are prohibited. Online sales, mail order, and third-party delivery platform sales (e.g., DoorDash) are allowed in-state only, but require the producer to offer the customer an opportunity to directly interact (face-to-face or virtually) before purchase. A separate \$75,000 cap applies if all products are priced at \$250 or more per item. Honey and maple syrup have a separate exemption permitting indirect retail sales up to \$15,000/year.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Michigan state law does not require a permit from the local health department. Muskegon County unincorporated areas governed by township zoning; City of Muskegon has separate ordinances. Producers should check with local township or city. No county URLs provided in input.

No. No routine inspection. MDARD may investigate upon complaint.

Direct sales from home, farmers markets, online with in-state delivery (virtual interaction required under 2025 amendment).

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health departments license food service. Michigan cottage food is an exemption. A commissary is a food service establishment licensed by the local health department.
