Where to file

State

Minnesota registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales are limited to direct-to-consumer channels: community events, farmers markets, from the producer's home, online (in-state delivery by the producer personally or by mail/commercial delivery), and fundraising donations. Restaurants, retail stores, roadside stands, mail order wholesale, and catering are prohibited. All deliveries must be made by the producer personally unless shipped by mail or commercial delivery upon a prior online sale. Home-canned products in the pH/water-activity exemption category (Subd. 1(a)(2)) may not be sold outside of Minnesota.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Chisago County may require a home occupation permit or zoning approval for home-based businesses. No specific county-level cottage food ordinance identified. Contact Chisago County Planning & Zoning.

Health

No. No routine inspections. MDA may investigate upon complaint.

Business license

Pickup / delivery

Tier 1: direct sales only. Tier 2: direct and indirect (retail store) sales allowed. Online sales permitted.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

MDA licenses food; local health may license food service. Minnesota cottage foods is an exemption. A commissary typically needs an MDA food handler license and/or a local food-service license, depending on the kitchen.
