Where to file

State

Mississippi registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Mississippi prohibits Internet sales, mail order, wholesale, and retail establishment sales. Cottage food products may only be sold through in-person direct-to-consumer channels including events, farmers markets, home sales, and roadside stands. Advertising on the Internet including social media is permitted even though sales through those channels are not.

Zoning / home occupation

Unknown. No county-level home occupation permit ordinance identified for unincorporated Alcorn County. Operators in Corinth should check Corinth city code separately.

Health

Upon-complaint. Mississippi MSDH may inspect upon complaint. No routine inspections required under §75-29-951.

Business license

Unknown

Pickup / delivery

Mississippi cottage food law requires direct-to-consumer sales only; home pickup is permitted. Internet sales and mail order are prohibited.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

MSDH permits food establishments. Mississippi cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the Mississippi State Department of Health.
