Hinds County, Mississippi. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Mississippi registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Mississippi prohibits Internet sales, mail order, wholesale, and retail establishment sales. Cottage food products may only be sold through in-person direct-to-consumer channels including events, farmers markets, home sales, and roadside stands. Advertising on the Internet including social media is permitted even though sales through those channels are not.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Hinds County and City of Jackson zoning rules apply. Jackson may require a business license or home occupation permit. No specific county-level cottage food permit documented beyond state registration exemption. Operators should verify with Hinds County or their municipal planning/zoning office.

Health

Upon-complaint. Mississippi State Department of Health may inspect upon consumer complaint or suspected foodborne illness. No routine inspections for cottage food operations.

Pickup / delivery

Mississippi cottage food law restricts to direct sales to consumers. Home pickup permitted. No internet sales, mail order, or wholesale channels allowed under state law.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

MSDH permits food establishments. Mississippi cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the Mississippi State Department of Health.
