What you need

Madison County, Mississippi. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Mississippi registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Mississippi prohibits Internet sales, mail order, wholesale, and retail establishment sales. Cottage food products may only be sold through in-person direct-to-consumer channels including events, farmers markets, home sales, and roadside stands. Advertising on the Internet including social media is permitted even though sales through those channels are not.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Madison County and the City of Canton may have home occupation zoning requirements. The input data fields for this county were malformed (field values appear shifted), but state law governs cottage food. No specific Madison County cottage food ordinance identified.

Health

Upon-complaint. Complaint-based only per state law. No routine inspections.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer sales only. No internet sales, mail order, wholesale, or retail establishment sales permitted. In-person direct sales only at home, farmers markets, roadside stands, and events.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

MSDH permits food establishments. Mississippi cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the Mississippi State Department of Health.
