Where to file

State

Montana registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Upon-complaint. Consignment sales at retail food establishments or through wholesale establishments are explicitly prohibited under §50-50-116(3). The Montana Local Food Choice Act also requires direct producer-to-informed-end-consumer transactions only; retail locations require a wholesale food license.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. A home occupancy license or certificate may be required. City of Great Falls Planning: 406-455-8414 (City of Great Falls Home Occupation Application). Unincorporated areas: Cascade County Planning Department: 406-454-6905 (Cascade County Home Occupation Permit Application). This is explicitly noted in the Cascade County Cottage Food Operation guidance document.

Health

Upon-complaint. Applicant grants local health official access to residence for inspection in event of complaint based on illness associated with products. No routine inspection.

Business license

Conditional

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales to consumers at farmers markets, events, and from home. Under standard cottage food (§50-50-116), no consignment/retail/wholesale. Under MLFCA, broader direct-to-consumer transactions permitted.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DPHHS / local health license retail food. Montana cottage food and the Local Food Choice Act are home paths. A commissary is a retail food establishment licensed by the local health department.
