Where to file

State

Nebraska registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales must be direct-to-consumer. Wholesale to restaurants, grocery stores, or distributors is not permitted under the cottage food framework. Non-TCS foods may be mailed; TCS foods must be delivered in person by the producer within 2 hours.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Kearney County is a small south-central Nebraska county along the Platte River. Unincorporated areas likely have minimal or no county zoning. City of Minden has its own municipal zoning.

Health

No. No routine inspection required; complaint-driven investigation possible

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct delivery to consumer permitted in-state; no wholesale to retailers

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health or NDA, depending on the kitchen. Nebraska cottage food is a home exemption. A commissary is a food establishment. Ask the kitchen whether the local health department or the Department of Agriculture licenses that facility.
