Where to file

State

Nevada registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Under the pre-2025 law (NRS 446.866), sales must be in-person transactions only — no internet or phone sales. Products may not be sold to wholesalers, brokers, distributors, or retail establishments for resale. AB352 (2025) amends this to allow phone and internet transactions with delivery via mail or food delivery service, but product relinquishment must still occur in Nevada. Local rules vary significantly: Clark County (Las Vegas), Washoe County, Carson City, and Douglas County have separate health authority requirements.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Carson City is an independent consolidated municipality. Operators should contact Carson City's Community Development Department for home occupation or business license requirements. Carson City has its own local regulatory framework.

Pickup / delivery

Under AB352 (2025): in-person sales, phone/internet orders with in-person or mail/delivery fulfillment allowed. No wholesale to distributors, retailers, or restaurants.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health authorities permit food establishments. Nevada cottage food is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the local health authority (for example SNHD in Clark County).
