HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

New York registers home processors at the state. Home Processor registration is with the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets, not the county health department. Suffolk, Nassau, and other county health pages will not have a separate cottage-food application. Confirm labeling and the AGM registration page in this file.

Where to file

State

New York registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Wholesale to restaurants, cafes, and grocery stores within New York State is explicitly permitted. Products may also be sold online (NY residents only) and via delivery. Shipping out of state is not permitted. Registration is free, location-specific, and has no expiration date.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies by city. NYC operators should consult NYC zoning code for home-based business rules. No specific NYC cottage food home occupation permit requirement identified; however, NYC zoning regulates accessory uses in residential districts and operators should verify compliance with NYC Admin Code. State guidance advises consulting local zoning officials before starting.

Health

No. No routine inspection under the Home Processor Exemption; state Ag & Markets may investigate complaints. NYC DOHMH may inspect upon complaint.

Business license

Varies by city

Pickup / delivery

Sales within New York State only (internet sales allowed within NY). Wholesale to local restaurants, cafes, and grocery stores is permitted within NYS. No out-of-state sales.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is Article 20-C or a health permit, not Home Processor. New York Home Processor is a state AGM registration for a home kitchen. If you hold a DOH permit or AGM 20-C license, homemade food must be made at that licensed facility. A commissary is that licensed facility.
