HOW THIS PLACE WORKS

New York registers home processors at the state. Home Processor registration is with the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets, not the county health department. Suffolk, Nassau, and other county health pages will not have a separate cottage-food application. Confirm labeling and the AGM registration page in this file.

Where to file

State

New York registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Wholesale to restaurants, cafes, and grocery stores within New York State is explicitly permitted. Products may also be sold online (NY residents only) and via delivery. Shipping out of state is not permitted. Registration is free, location-specific, and has no expiration date.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Richmond County (Staten Island) is a borough of New York City. NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene governs food safety within all five boroughs. NYC may have additional requirements beyond NY state Home Processor program. Contact NYC DOHMH for borough-specific requirements. NYC general home occupation rules apply through NYC Zoning Resolution.

All venues permitted: direct from home, farmers markets, retail stores, online, mail delivery, interstate. No annual sales cap. NY Home Processor registration required.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is Article 20-C or a health permit, not Home Processor. New York Home Processor is a state AGM registration for a home kitchen. If you hold a DOH permit or AGM 20-C license, homemade food must be made at that licensed facility. A commissary is that licensed facility.
