Cumberland County, North Carolina. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

North Carolina registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Yes. Home processors may sell to retail stores, restaurants, and directly to consumers. Sales at farmers markets are permitted. Labels are required for wholesale and packaged self-service retail; direct hand-to-consumer sales (e.g., from home or at events) may be exempt from affixed labels if ingredient info is available on request. NC requires annual home kitchen inspection, which is unusual among no-cap states.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. NC NCAGR requires operators to check local planning/zoning before applying. Cumberland County and City of Fayetteville may require home occupation permit. Operator must verify with local planning department per NCAGR Step 4 guidance

Health

Yes. Initial inspection required before operating; subsequent complaint-based inspections possible

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct and indirect sales allowed; retail stores, restaurants, farmers markets, online all permitted within NC

If you rent a commissary kitchen

NCDA or the local health department, depending on the food. North Carolina home processors register with NCDA. A commissary used as a food service kitchen is typically permitted by the local health department; a food manufacturing plant is NCDA. Ask the kitchen which license they operate under.
