Where to file

State

North Carolina registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Yes. Home processors may sell to retail stores, restaurants, and directly to consumers. Sales at farmers markets are permitted. Labels are required for wholesale and packaged self-service retail; direct hand-to-consumer sales (e.g., from home or at events) may be exempt from affixed labels if ingredient info is available on request. NC requires annual home kitchen inspection, which is unusual among no-cap states.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. No state-level home occupation permit required beyond NCDA&CS home processor registration. Wilson County may have local zoning home occupation requirements. No Wilson County-specific cottage food ordinance found.

Health

Yes. Annual inspection of the home kitchen required by NC Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (NCDA&CS). Application and fee required.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct and indirect sales permitted. Shelf-stable products may be sold at farmers markets, roadside stands, online, and through other channels. No sales cap.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

NCDA or the local health department, depending on the food. North Carolina home processors register with NCDA. A commissary used as a food service kitchen is typically permitted by the local health department; a food manufacturing plant is NCDA. Ask the kitchen which license they operate under.
