Where to file

State

Ohio registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Labeled cottage food products may be sold to or used by retail food establishments and food service operations licensed under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3717. This enables indirect/wholesale sales within Ohio. Products may not be sold outside the state of Ohio.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Ohio state cottage food law does not require a permit or registration. Medina County local zoning may require home occupation permit for home-based businesses in residential zones. County URLs were blank in input; no specific county ordinance verified.

Health

No. No routine inspections. Ohio Dept. of Agriculture may investigate upon complaint.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales only within Ohio. In-state delivery and farmers market sales permitted. No out-of-state sales.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

ODA cottage food is not a food-service license. Ohio cottage food may be sold to licensed food-service operations. Baking in a commissary means that kitchen's food-service or food-establishment license applies. Local health departments license food service.
