Where to file

State

Ohio registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Labeled cottage food products may be sold to or used by retail food establishments and food service operations licensed under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3717. This enables indirect/wholesale sales within Ohio. Products may not be sold outside the state of Ohio.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Troy and other municipalities in Miami County may have home occupation zoning requirements. No specific Miami County cottage food ordinance identified. Operators should check with their local municipality.

Health

No. No routine inspections. Ohio cottage food operations are exempt from ODA licensing.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Sales permitted at home, farmers markets, events. Indirect sales (to retailers) also permitted. Products cannot be sold outside Ohio. No reduced oxygen packaging.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

ODA cottage food is not a food-service license. Ohio cottage food may be sold to licensed food-service operations. Baking in a commissary means that kitchen's food-service or food-establishment license applies. Local health departments license food service.
