Canadian County, Oklahoma. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Oklahoma registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales are permitted on site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules to allow sales at other locations or by other means. County ordinances may regulate but may not conflict with or impede the Act. For TCS foods, the producer must complete an approved food safety training (e.g., ServSafe Food Handler Training, max 8 hours, available online) before selling.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Canadian County may require a home occupation permit under local zoning. City of El Reno has its own zoning rules. No county-specific cottage food overlay identified.

Health

No. No routine inspection. OSDH may investigate complaint or foodborne illness.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Sales allowed at any venue — home, events, farmers markets, online, retail (for non-TCS foods). Limited indirect sales allowed. No geographic restriction within Oklahoma.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service license, not Food Freedom. Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment licensed by the State Department of Health.
